Women's Intuition~ Is it a Sixth Sense?

God has created women with a special gift called intuition. This amazing ability helps women sense things that may not be obvious to others. It's like having a sixth sense that guides them in making important decisions.

The intuition of women is their uncanny ability to know what others are thinking or feeling, and their ability to understand situations that have to do with emotions, and they are almost always right.

There is no proof for "Women's Intuition." **However**, science and Biblical discernment are two areas that coincide and connect, not collide, with the make-up of women's ability to see beyond the obvious and into a world that is constantly trying to fool mankind.

First, let's look at the Science Behind Women's Intuition:

- Frontiers in Neuroscience states that [women's brains have more developed left zones](#) for speech and verbal ability, allowing them to articulate complex feelings verbally and behaviorally.
- A [thicker bundle of nerve fibers](#) in women than men facilitates better communication between brain hemispheres, potentially enhancing their intuitive abilities. This would be the reason for saying a woman has a "sixth sense."
 - ✓ While not physically proven, this sixth sense likely contributes to women's intuition observed in everyday life.
You have probably heard in your lifetime..."Trust your mother's intuition."
 - ✓ Some think the woman's "sixth sense" contributes to connecting this skill to women's ability to multitask and process information more efficiently than men (Sorry about that, men).

- ***Whether proven by science or not, what is obvious is that women's intuition is powerful and we see it all around us every day, from a mother to a wife, and a coworker.***

Women's Intuition in a Marriage

Female intuition in a marriage relationship is their ability to perceive and understand subtle emotional cues and non-verbal communication between the husband and wife.

- In a marriage, women apply their intuition without effort. They can perceive and discern when their husband is sad or thoughtful.
- This helps in making decisions for both the husband and wife.
- The wife can go anticipate or detect when a husband is not telling the full story about a situation...or get the cues from his actions at best.

The intuition of women allows them to empathize with their husband, anticipate their needs, and detect emotional shifts that might give way to not getting the necessary information for a major decision.

- ✓ It can lead to a deeper emotional connection and the ability to offer support and comfort when needed.
- ✓ Wives may pick up on cues that men might overlook, contributing to a more holistic understanding of the situation.

While not infallible, women's intuition can play a valuable role in encouraging trust, communication, and mutual understanding within the overall relationship...physically, emotionally, mentally, and spiritually.

The Role of Faith in Intuition (Biblical Perspective)

Our intuition is significantly impacted by our faith. The verses in this devotion illustrate how reliance on God enriches our inner guidance, allowing us to act courageously in response to life's challenges. They highlight the necessity of faith as we trust our intuition.

Whether in relationships, work, or personal life, trusting this gift can help women navigate their paths with confidence and faith.

Please note that Men certainly can take these Scriptures and apply it to their lives. The Scriptures are good for everyone with a desire to seek the heart of God.

- **Hebrews 11:1**, "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." –

This verse illuminates the essence of faith as believing in what we cannot see. Our intuition often leads us in directions that may not yet be clear, and trusting in God's plan allows us to move forward with assurance.

- **Romans 10:17**, *"Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ."*

This verse teaches us that faith is built through God's word. When we immerse ourselves in the Scriptures, our intuition can be sharpened, leading us to a more profound connection with God and clarity in our decisions.

- **2 Corinthians 5:7** *"For we live by faith, not by sight."*

This verse reminds us that our lives are guided by faith, which often fuels our intuition. We may not perceive things as they are, but trusting God through our intuition helps us move forward along our path with confidence.

Community plays a crucial role in our lives, as we come together in faith and support of one another. In this section, the verses remind us that our intuition can guide us in building strong relationships, encouraging us to engage with those around us. When we trust our God-Given instincts, we can cultivate a thriving community of believers.

- **Hebrews 10:24-25**, *"And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching."*

This verse encourages us to be active in our community. Trusting our intuition can inspire us to uplift one another, reminding us of the importance of gathering and supporting each other in our walk of faith.

We often hear the phrase "follow your heart," and within the Scriptures, we find guidance that connects this idea of following our intuition with God's teachings.

The Bible encourages us to listen to our hearts and trust that God's wisdom will lead us to the right decisions.

- **Proverbs 16:9**, *"In their hearts, humans plan their course, but the LORD establishes their steps."*

This verse reveals the balance between our intentions and God's guidance. Our hearts can desire many things, but ultimately, trusting in God ensures we are directed toward the best choices in life.

- **Jeremiah 29:11**, *"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."*

There isn't a more reassuring verse than this as to God's plans for our lives.

It is imperative to align our intuition with His intentions, bringing hope, allowing us to make decisions without fear, and knowing He is guiding us toward a bright future.

- **Psalm 32:8**, *“I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you.”* –

This verse emphasizes God’s promise to guide us. Trusting our intuition can be nurtured through prayer, as we seek God’s instructions on how to navigate our choices in life.

There are two (2) areas I have somewhat overlooked as to the Woman’s ability to see, or at least feel, that are important in properly navigating the world’s challenges.

1. **Parenting:** Mothers can intuitively understand their child’s needs, even when the child is unable to communicate verbally.
2. **Safety:** Women may have a heightened sense of danger or discomfort in certain situations, leading them to take precautionary measures.

Final Thoughts

As we reflect on the various scriptures about a woman’s intuition, we see divine guidance and the importance of listening to our inner voice, the Holy Spirit. The Bible uses a more defining word for appropriate and God-Given intuition. It is **DISCERNMENT**.

- *In its simplest definition, discernment is nothing more than the ability to decide between truth and error, right and wrong.*
- *Discernment is the process of making careful distinctions in our thinking about truth.*
- *Although discernment is engrained in the human brain (thinking process), only the Christian has the Spirit of God within him to make right choices at the right time.*

When one reaches the age of accountability, he must make a choice to humble himself and yield to God’s way (the truth) or take on the world’s bombardment of choices by his own choosing. He is on his own without the Spirit of God in him.

All the verses remind us that our **DISCERNMENT/intuition, coupled with faith**, can guide us through life’s journey confidently. We can support one another in relationships and encourage community, drawing strength from our shared beliefs. By trusting our intuition (empowered by the Holy Spirit), we grow closer to God, and He helps us illuminate our paths with clarity. Trusting the Holy Spirit’s leading (discernment/intuition) helps us lead rich, fulfilling lives, reflecting God’s love in our relationships as we support one another.
